**F, 3 yrs old**

**Weight:** 25 lbs

**Characteristics:** bad breath

**Reward:** dental exam and cleaning to address tartar and gum disease



## LUMPY fugitive

**Sandy Brown, Mixed Breed**

**M, 10 yrs old**

**Weight:** 40 lbs

**Characteristics:** lumps and bumps of varying sizes on body

**Reward:** assessment and early detection/treatment of potentially cancerous growths



## SNIFFLES persistent sneezer

**Domestic Medium-length Hair,  
Gray Tabby**

**M, 16 wks old**

**Weight:** 4 lbs

**Characteristics:** drippy nose and runny eyes

**Reward:** exam and treatment to identify cause and prevent complications
